Participation Rules

Registration

- Only Two entries per college will be registered
- Each team shall include only currently enrolled students of the college. Roll numbers shall be submitted along with the names of team members at the time of registration.
- Registrations will close half an hour before the commencement of the event.
- Registration shall be based on first come first serve.

Reporting Requirements

- Registered teams and all the members of the team should report at the venue in the premises of BNC, Kair at least an hour before the start of the event.
- It is compulsory for all participants and non-participants to carry their college ID cards.
- The coordinator of the team must confirm their readiness to perform on stage to the anchor five minutes before the start of their performance.
- The coordinator is required to be in touch with the BNC organising team for getting the up to date information about the event schedule, time slot allotted for the presentation by the team

Stage Show Preparation Requirements

- The teams are free to choose any theme but the show must be designed and presented for viewing by audiences of all age groups.
- The presentation should be completely devoid of anything that is offensive or insensitive to cultural and religious sentiments.
- A green room would be provided at the venue for the purpose of changing dresses.
- The team should carry the music to be played along the show in a single track recorded in CD or other media which can be connected to standard sound system and must be handed over to the BNC organising team at least 20 Minutes before the start of the show for test play.

Stage Show Presentation Requirements

- A team which fails to perform during its allotted slot will not be given any second chance.
- Obscenity, vulgarity and wardrobe malfunction of any sort will lead to automatic and instant disqualification of the team.

- Do not use fire, inflammable substance, or live arms of any type as props.
- All props, etc. used by the teams must be cleared from the stage immediately after the performance and from the college premises by the end of the day.

Discipline & Decorum

- Participants must maintain decorum inside the campus. Instances of misbehaviour of even a single member of the team will lead to the disqualification of the entire team and the team will be required to leave the campus instantly.
- Disruptive behaviour of any kind intended to disturb/disrupt the event is not allowed. These include but not limited to running around, screaming, shouting, or yelling, playing loud music, rowdiness, and unsolicited physical contact, defacing or damaging anything at the venue or in the college campus.
- Use of cigarettes, alcohol, narcotic substances and all unfair means are strictly prohibited. Violators will be handed over to the concerned authorities.
- Discriminatory or derogatory utterances as well as harassment of any sort involving any contest participant, member of the audience or the organising team will be treated as breach of discipline and decorum and dealt with severely.

Stage Show Judgement and Prizes

- Stage performance of the teams will be judged based on the creative, aesthetic and artistic qualities of the total presentation including the theme, costumes, music, choreography, and confidence.
- Negative marking will be applied if the stage presentation exceeds the allotted time limit.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- Cash prizes will be awarded to the winning teams.

Rules for Instrumental Music

1. Two entries per college
2. Time limit- 4+1 minutes
3. The instrument has to be brought by the candidate only.

Rules for Poster making

1. Two entries per college
2. Time limit will be 1 hour
3. Theme will be given on the spot
4. Only chart will be provided by the college

Rules for Fireless Cooking

1. Two entries per college
2. Time limit will be 30 minutes
3. Items for preparation of food and presentation of the same shall be brought by the participants only.

Rules for Debate

1. Topic: "Our Votes- Do they matter?"
2. Medium of language – Hindi or English
3. Two entries per college
4. Each participant will get 4 minutes for presentation

Rules for Solo Singing

1. Two entries per college
2. Time limit- 3+ 1 minutes

Rules for Duet Dance

1. Two entries per college
2. Time limit- 3+1 minutes
3. The candidates are required to bring their own CDs or pen drive.

Rules for Kavita Path

1. Two entries per college
2. Time limit- 4+1 minutes

Rules for Nukkad Natak

1. One team (Maximum -20 students & Minimum -8 Students) per college
2. Time limit-15+5 minutes

Rules for Group Dance

1. One team (Maximum -15 students & Minimum -6 Students) per college
2. Time limit-4+2 minutes
3. The candidates are required to bring their own CDs or pen drive.

Rules for Solo dance

1. Two entries per college
2. Time limit- 3+1 minutes
3. The candidates are required to bring their own CDs or pen drive.

Rules for Fashion Show

- Only Two entries per college will be registered
- Each team shall not have more than 15 members including the choreographer, director/coordinator and helpers. Each team shall have a minimum of six student models on the show.
- Time limit for every team would be 10 minutes (including set-up and the performance)
- Stage show presented by the team must include 1 to 2 Minutes of introduction highlighting the theme, the inspiration, etc. within the overall time limit of 10 Minutes
